The Specialist Upskilling Programme (SUP) is a collection of CITB short duration courses. When combined with a period of assessment this course can lead to a Level 2 Vocational Qualification (VQ) in Reinforced Bituminous membranes (RBM). The course covers:

- General Health and Safety
- Preparation of materials, planning and storage
- Safe use of tools
- Preparation of roof decking
- Vapour Control Layers
- Insulation types and attachment
- Setting out
- Installing Reinforced Bituminous Membrane (RBM)
- RBM detailing
- Protection, inspection and testing
- Safe2Torch (NFRC initiative)

Course Requirements

- As the assessment is completed on site the individual will need to be in full time employment or carrying out work experience
- Previous roofing knowledge is recommended
- There is no age limit

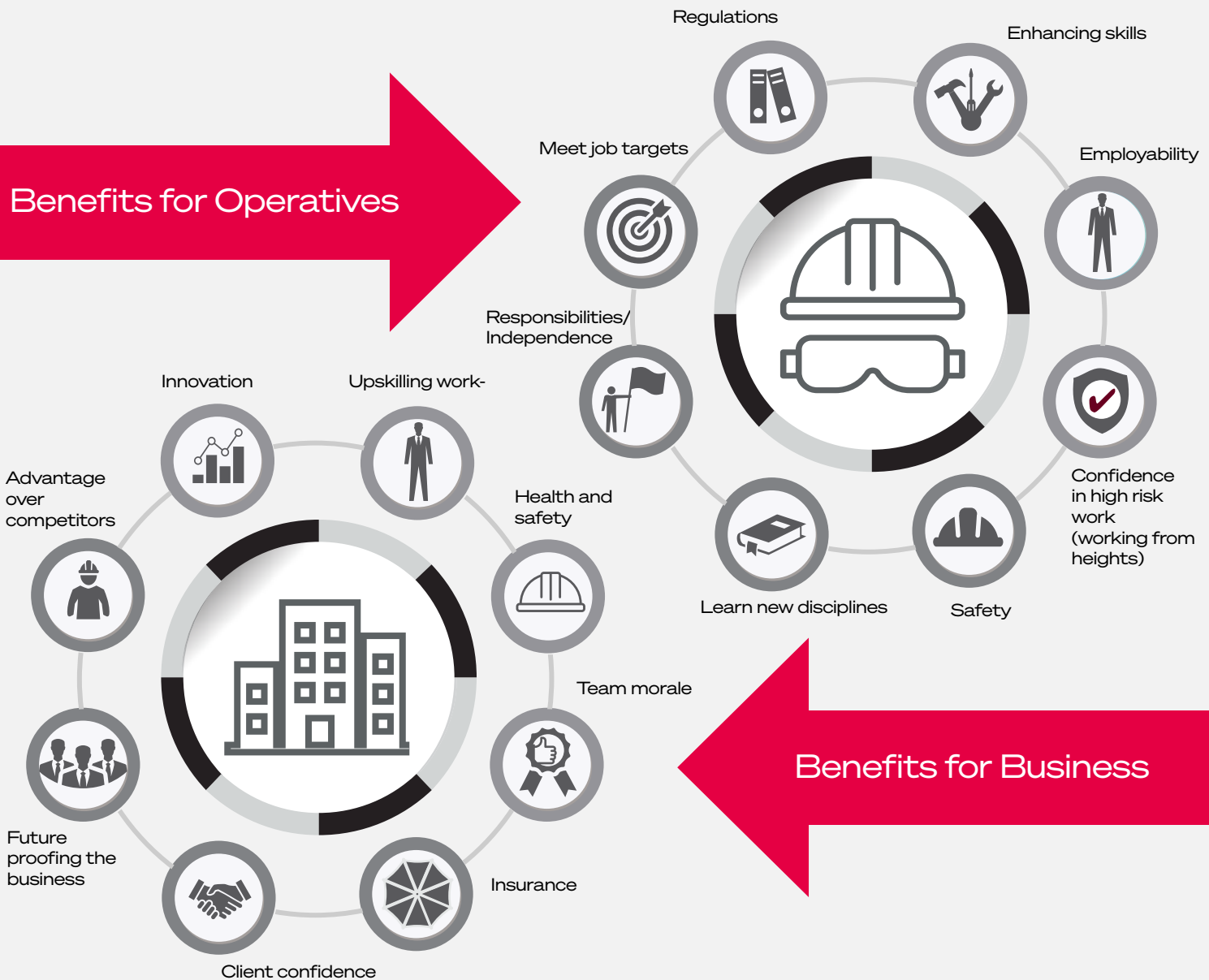
